Curriculum for MPhil(BIOL)

(For students admitted in 2010-11)

Program Requirements for Master of Philosophy (MPhil) Program in Biology

Credits

- 1. To complete at least 6 credits of approved LIFS courses at 4000-level or above, or others approved by the Department. Students with a first degree in an area other than that their postgraduate program may be required to take additional courses.
- 2. No credit transfer will be allowed.

Independent Study

To continuously register in LIFS 6410 *Independent Study* throughout the residency.

Postgraduate Seminar

To continuously register in LIFS 6110 *Life Science Seminar I* ¹ and LIFS 6120 *Life Science Seminar II* ¹throughout the residency with at least 3 passes.

Research and MPhil Thesis Examination

- 1. To conduct research and enroll in LIFS 6990 MPhil Thesis Research; and
- 2. To defend the MPhil thesis successfully.

Concentration

In addition to the existing program requirements, students who opt for the Molecular Medicine concentration are required to:

- 1. Take LIFS 6660 *Molecular Medicine* and other approved LIFS courses at 4000-level or above to finish the 6 credits of required coursework; and
- 2. Conduct research in the area of molecular medicine.

Note 1: Students with research focus in Marine and Environmental Science may take ENVS 6011 *Postgraduate Seminar* to substitute LIFS 6110 and LIFS 6120.
