Program Requirements for Master of Science (MSc) Program in Computer Science and Engineering*

Credits

To complete **30 credits** of coursework.

Courses

- 1. 27 credits of course, independent study or project credits, with at least 3 course credits each in at least four of the following areas:
 - Foundations of Computer Science
 - Artificial Intelligence
 - Networking and Computing Systems
 - Data, Knowledge and Information Systems
 - Software and Applications
 - Vision and Graphics
- 2. COMP 690/691 Computer Science and Engineering Seminar I/II
- 3. LANG 501 Postgraduate English for Academic Purposes

Courses may be taken from either the Department's MPhil/PhD course offerings or from the MSc(IT) course offerings. Students should read the course descriptions carefully to note exclusions among courses offered by these programs.

Credit Transfer

For students transferring in the program from a research postgraduate program of the University, they may transfer up to 17 credits of coursework which had not been used for another academic award.
