

# In-house Staff Development Training Scheme (IHSD) Application for Admissions in 2024-25 Fall Term Notes for Applicants

The following is only applicable to HKUST staff who intend to study courses offered on campus.

## 1. Background

Full-time non-academic staff of HKUST, with approval of their Head of Department, may apply for admission to undergraduate (UG) or postgraduate (PG) taught courses offered by the University on a part-time basis under the IHSD Scheme.

Staff participating in the IHSD Scheme will only enroll for UG/PG courses. PG courses offered by the School of Business and Management are not covered under this Scheme. If you wish to pursue degree study, please apply for admission via the University websites at <a href="https://join.hkust.edu.hk/">https://join.hkust.edu.hk/</a> (for UG degrees) or <a href="https://fytqs.hkust.edu.hk/apply">https://fytqs.hkust.edu.hk/apply</a> (for PG degrees).

Admission is subject to availability of study places with priority given to full-time students of the University. Staff leaving the University will not be able to continue with their courses.

# 2. Eligibility

Staff participants must be selected and nominated by their Head of Department for the purpose of career progression. Candidates should demonstrate an adequate standard of English proficiency and may be required to sit an English Language Test in mid-August 2024 as part of the selection process. ## 3. Application Procedures and Deadline

Interested staff should first seek prior support from your Head of Department before submitting your application.

Please submit the following application materials to the Undergraduate Recruitment and Admissions Office (URAO) for UG courses or the HKUST Fok Ying Tung Graduate School (FYTGS) for PG courses on or before 15 August 2024 (Thursday) via internal mail:

- ☑ Application Form;
- ☑ Documents Substantiating Academic Qualifications, e.g. Official Transcripts, Copies of Degree Certificates/Diplomas and/or Testimonials of Current Study; and
- ☑ Copy of Proof of English Language Proficiency, if any.

## 4. Tuition Fees

UG courses: HK\$1,690 per credit
 PG courses: HK\$1,754 per credit

Tuition fees are **NOT** refundable or transferable.



## 5. Course List and Choices

Each applicant may apply for a maximum of 3 choices for course admission in the order of priority but will only be admitted to a *maximum of 2 courses* in each Term. Only UG courses and selected TPG courses are offered under this Scheme.

Applicant may make use of different class search criteria (eg. "Term", "Course Subject", "Course Career" or "Additional Search Criteria, etc.) to identify appropriate course.

Applicants will be notified of their application results in mid-to-late August 2024.

# 7. Departmental Support

Applicants seeking support from their Department, in terms of time release and/or funding support, should pay attention to the following:

- Paid study leave and/or funding support may be granted at the discretion of the Head of Department, subject to the operation requirements, availability of funds, and staff member's satisfactory completion of the approved course/program.
- Paid study leave may be granted up to half of the total day release period required and a maximum of 30 half-day sessions per year.
- Approval from VPAB and post-development service will be required for financial sponsorship reaching the thresholds.
